

Dear Friends in Christ,

These last few weeks I have found myself spending more time in prayer – spoken and silent – than ever before. Maybe you have, too? There are so many needs. How can we not lift up our neighbors in Afghanistan and Haiti as they continue to experience crisis, conflict and disaster? I can only imagine the exhaustion of the firefighters still battling wildfires and the frustration of health care workers struggling to remain compassionate toward the unvaccinated. It's been agonizing to watch kids and educators anxiously and cautiously return to in-person learning at the same time covid cases are increasing and affecting much younger people.

If you are struggling to find words, please know that it is more than ok to simply sit in silent communion with God, trusting God to hear the silent prayers of your heart. If you're seeking words, this prayer from our partners at Lutheran Disaster Response might help:

- "The Wheat and the Weeds" Ari Hermann helped tell the story of the "Parable of the Weeds" by retelling it in a "rap" format. 
A special thank you goes to Ricki Fehr as she is editing our weekly Sunday School lessons and getting them ready for online viewing.




