



Waiting and Anticipating - The Blessings of Advent

The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not overcome it. John 1:5

Waiting. It is NOT something any of us likes to do, but it IS a part of our everyday lives. We wait in lines to buy

groceries, to see a movie. We wait in traffic for lights to change. Sometimes our waiting is filled with anxiety or frustration. Waiting for test results or waiting for someone to respond to our apology and request for forgiveness. Sometimes we're late and every red traffic light seems to add to our stress. Other times we're waiting for something good - maybe a new grandbaby to be born or a special vacation. Waiting can be hard, but waiting can also have benefits. When we wait for something, it gives us an opportunity to reflect on our priorities, on what's important and what's not. And even if waiting is not welcome, waiting also give us time to pray, to turn our attention to God's presence and God's promises. IF we let it, waiting often opens our hearts and minds to be more vulnerable, more thankful, more loving, more giving, more patient . . . with ourselves and the people and situations around us.

Start a NEW tradition: beginning December 1, read one chapter of the book of Luke in the Bible each evening. There are 24 chapters. On Christmas Eve you will have read an entire account of Jesus' life and wake up Christmas morning knowing WHO and WHY we celebrate!!

The four weeks of Advent are the start of the church year. It is a season of waiting, a season of reflection and anticipation. In contrast to the world rushing toward Christmas, the Church waits for the celebration of Jesus' birth. Advent helps to reorient us to God's purposes. It is time to reflect on what Jesus' life, death and resurrection means for our lives, our priorities. We're challenged to ask ourselves: Are we living FOR Jesus and to serve God's priorities? Or are we living for ourselves and for our own comfort? Are we fighting against God's will or are we actively seeking ways to be instruments of God's Hope, Peace, Joy and Love - the themes of each of the Sundays in Advent? As we answer those questions, advent waiting can truly become joyous anticipation. If we let it, Advent introspection can give way to a renewed relationship between us and our God who came down from heaven to become one of us. God, in Jesus, CHOOSES to love us, to forgive

us, to save us from our sin and free us to live for the sake of our neighbor, for

the sake of Christ.

While frustrating, waiting can remind us we are NOT in control of things or people or the future. May our Advent waiting remind us that we are loved by

and we worship our God who was, who is and who ever more shall be. And we ARE


