



As the new year begins, I can't help but give thanks for all of God's blessings that have filled the last almost 19 months of my time with all of you here at Emanuel. It has been my joy and privilege to have shared ministry with you as God prepares you to welcome and partner with a new "settled" pastor in the coming year. And while neither you nor I know God's timing or what the future holds, knowing the ONE who holds our future can give us courage and fill us with joyful expectation of what's ahead . . .

Transitions can create anxiety, but they can also create energy for trying new things. Together we



have worshipped and prayed, read and studied the Bible, shared laughter and tears and held hands in hospital rooms as well as living rooms. REACHING OUT IN OUR OWN LA HABRA COMMUNITY

November, 2022 – 37 Thanksgiving Bags for Patriots and Paws, amounting to almost \$1700 were delivered on November 13. What a joy to provide a special Thanksgiving to those persons who have served our Country!

December, 2022 – Angel Tree for WINGS Shelter, for victims of domestic violence. We had 6 families with 19 family members represented. As always, Emanuel exceeded all expectations. We could barely get all of the gifts into Jo Ellen Dobson's Excursion. The people who sponsor the WINGS shelter were overwhelmed.

FOOD FOR OUR HUNGRY NEIGHBORS

We have become aware of an opportunity in our community to help feed even more people. First Lutheran Church in Fullerton sponsors a food bank each week in addition to providing a free meal every Tuesday evening at "THE TABLE". Emanuel will partner with them on the food bank and will be encouraging our members to provide food directly and we will purchase additional items from the monetary gifts given to HAHO. Our plan is deliver these items to First Lutheran on the last week of each month. They feed hundreds of our neighbors every week!

Here are the specific requested items: (Packages designed for families)

1 or 2 pound bags of rice (they use 100 every week)

12 – 16 oz. plastic jars of peanut better (crunchy preferred)

12 - 16 oz. packages of any variety of pasta

Canned tuna or chicken

Shelf stable milk (almond or soy – no refrigeration required)

Please keep this list handy and consider this when shopping and bring your items the last Sunday of every month and place in the food cart in the narthex.

In addition, as you are able, HAHO encourages you to continue to contribute non-perishable food items to the carts in the narthex, which are faithfully carried to the food bank at the Gary Center by Ricki Fehr every week.




What you need:
