

Over the years there has been one word in my vocabulary that has defined Christmas. The word is "Incarnation." For me this word defines the day, the season, and really life with Jesus better than any other.

At Easter, and during the following weeks, we talk about the "living Lord." We refer to the Resurrection, Jesus walking with his disciples and providing new life for those who follow him. The impact of the Easter season goes without saying because of the long-lasting impact on our daily lives.

Christmas, and the Incarnation of Jesus is different. For me it brings to mind that the event occurred because God the Father made a decision for all creation. The Father came to a point in time when it was decided that the law of God just wasn't working out. I imagine that the Father looked down, saw Mary and Joseph her betrothed, knew of the faithfulness of both of them, knew they would serve as Jesus' first disciples, then being one with the Spirit, saw to it that she was to bear a son, the Son. I can't help but feel that in some mystical way the Father and the Spirit rejoiced because God would now be Incarnate on the earth. The presence of the Lord would be more powerful than it had ever been. The future of Creation was secure because God Incarnate would be among the people. He would be welcomed as a newborn, develop as a toddler, grow through adolescence and become a well adjusted adult. All this occurred while being cultivated in the synagogue and the Temple as the fulfillment of the law, the Messiah and Savior of the World.

We know of many other names for Jesus. This time of year especially we hear of Him as the Prince of Peace, the King of Kings and the Lord of Lords. But all of this began when the Father decided that the Incarnation would be the starting point.

This Christmas season I would pray that all people could find a new place in their heart to welcome this living God. As we greet a new year, I would additionally pray that the Incarnation lives on as we grow with this special presence of the Lord as he touches our lives each day.

A Blessed Incarnation to you all.







Angel Tree

Thankful for our Study Buddy Tutors who consistently help with children's learning.


Thankful for all those who help with check-in, Communion service, ushers, greeting, reading, sound booth, and all other needs at our worship services.

Thankful for Sharon Frazier, Candy Keller, and others who are re-working our Christmas banner so beautifully.







SEARCHING FOR SILVER

Godly, biblical wisdom is more valuable than gold or silver Make

Godly, biblical wisdom is more valuable than gold or silver. Make this do-it-yourself toy to practice your searching skills.

What you need:

- · 12 small, smooth rocks
- An empty, clean egg carton
- Paintbrush
- Acrylic paint (gold or silver)
- Black permanent marker

What you do:

- Clean the rocks and egg carton. Place newspaper on a table to protect it from paint.
- Paint all sides of the rocks and carton. Let dry. Add a second coat, if desired.
- 3. When rocks are dry, number each rock (1-12) with marker. Place rocks in the carton.
- 4. Play hide-and-seek with a friend. Take turns hiding the rocks in a room, sandbox or backyard. Give clues, if needed, and count the rocks as they're returned.
- Use your imagination to incorporate a treasure hunt into study time or family devotions.
