



Hello Emanuel Community,

I am honored to be writing to you for the first time. Given my newness in the congregation, I wanted to take this opportunity not only to share something about myself but also to give you a brief reflection as we approach Pentecost.

A fun fact about me: I coached baseball and softball for nine years. When called into ministry, I traded my coach's hat for a collar. One of the most meaningful lessons I learned from coaching is that while I can not always control the outcome of the game, I can pay attention to how I show up in my attitude and effort. This perspective has helped me navigate moments in ministry with a greater sense of peace and purpose.

As we approach Pentecost—the day we remember the outpouring of the Holy Spirit and the birth of the Church—we're reminded that God often moves in unexpected ways. Uncertain and gathered in one place, the disciples were suddenly empowered to speak, lead, and serve in new and courageous ways. However, it was their attitudes that allowed them to be vessels in this powerful transforming moment. Pentecost invites us to be open to the Spirit's movement, even when the path ahead feels unclear.

Each of us is a beloved child of God, created uniquely and purposefully. Just as every team is made stronger by the unique strengths of its players, I've already seen in my short time at Emanuel what a remarkable and gifted community this is. The Spirit is already moving in powerful ways among you—in your hospitality, dedication, and openness. I'm truly thrilled to be part of the pastoral team and filled with anticipation for what the Spirit has in store for our future together.

I look forward to getting to know each of you more deeply as we continue this journey of faith.

2025 Pacifica Synod Assembly

Thank you for the opportunity to attend the Pacifica Synod Assembly at Gloria Dei Lutheran Church in Dana Point. We had a day and a half packed full of sessions and activities. Our day began with a Mariachi Band opening up our Worship Service, afterwards we jumped right into business. We spent most of the morning listening to reports and stories. An example of one of the stories was about Maui's recovery from their devastating fires. Our Synod members donated \$534,800 to be shared among 9 organizations. Lutheran World Relief donated \$98,000 to provide portable showers and laundry services to people, many of whom are still living in their cars. There continues to be a great need for donations as the needs are still great and many donations are dropping off. Many other stories were scattered among the assembly. After lunch we began debating and passing resolutions and memorials. Pastor Laherty was recognized and honored for his 50 years of Rostered Ministry. We held elections for positions open within the Synod, and were more than educated about the budget of the Synod.

The second day included passing the budget for the next year and continuing discussion and voting on resolutions and memorials. An increase of 3% was passed for Rostered Ministers (both Ministers of the Word and Sacrament and Ministers of Word and Service). Resolutions and Memorials passed related to the ELCA committing to acknowledge and respect Missing and Murdered Indigenous women, girls, and 2S, caring for our Immigrant Neighbors, as well as members and for their mental health and spirituality. There was a call for Unity because we are all members of one body in Christ.

Pastor Laherty and I are available to answer any questions you may have.



Also, if you have crutches, walkers, canes, or manual wheel chairs you no longer need, they will be glad to take them. A tax donation letter is available upon request.




BOOK OF EPHESIANS WED 9-10 AM IN THE LIBRARY **NO EXPERIENCE NEEDED!!**


