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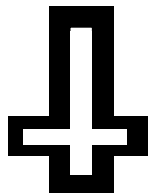

A NOTE FROM THE

AMANDA PULOS



September Newsletter

In January I was in Berkeley for my final intensive course at the seminary preparing to begin my internship with you as your Pastoral Intern. During that week I prayed for you, for me and for the community surrounding the campus. I also visited a café called The Good Table. This was no ordinary coffee shop; it was a collaboration between a church and the surrounding community, a place where hospitality, creativity, and ministry came together. Along the walls and shelves were handmade items ranging from soaps and clothing to artwork created by local artisans. It was there that I came across this photograph of a bridge.

At first, I was simply drawn to its beauty. I bought it because I liked it, not knowing how much it would mean to me over the months that followed. As internship has unfolded, I found myself returning to that image again and again. A bridge is not a place to build a home. It is not meant for standing still. A bridge exists to carry us from one place to another. There is only one direction we are called to move forward.

Internship has been a season of growth, learning, and trusting where God is leading. There have been moments of uncertainty, joy, challenge, and deep gratitude. There have also been moments when I wished I could see what was waiting on the other side. Yet God has faithfully continued to lead the way, even when the destination wasn't clear. Standing on the metaphorical bridge today, I have a better understanding of where the Spirit was moving me forward and I have only begun.

The more I reflect on this image, the more I realize it isn't just my story; it is Emanuel's story as well. This congregation has a rich history, a strong foundation, and a deep commitment to sharing Christ's love. Over these past months, I have witnessed the Spirit show up in ways I still can't fully explain: in worship, around council tables, in Bible studies, through conversations over coffee, and in the quiet acts of care that often go unnoticed. Those moments remind me of the mystery of God being at work here.

But the history of Emanuel is only one side of the bridge. There is still so much ministry ahead. Some of it we can already see, and some of it has not yet been revealed. As Emanuel continues walking along this metaphorical bridge, my prayer is that we won't be tempted to linger in what has been or become anxious about what we cannot yet see. Instead, may we trust the One who continues to call us forward, one faithful step at a time. As the prophet Isaiah reminds us, "I am about to do a new thing; now it springs forth, do you not perceive it?" (Isaiah 43:19).

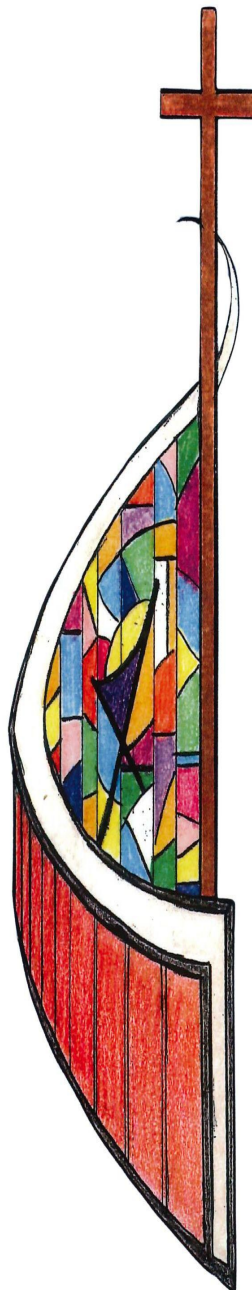

HAHO SEPTEMBER 2026 UPDATE

As we look to cooler temperature's and many exciting opportunities to serve our Lord, we would like to share some very exciting news from the Caring Hands Food Pantry. Our dear Denise Witcher who volunteers at this wonderful organization has shared what we see as a "Loaves and Fishes" miracle. Their director, Deenna Eley who spoke to us, shared that something incredible occurred in July in regard to their impact on those they help.

Historically November has been their highest demand month as families prepare for the holidays. In November of 2025, they impacted 775 households, 637 children, 1,311 adults and 616 seniors. But in July of 2026 they impacted 877 households, 647 children, 1395 adults and 811 seniors! Keeping in mind the expense of travel, high electric bills, entertaining children, etc. we call this a miracle and can only be our God blessing those you continue to bless through your filling the food baskets.

For that reason our focus will continue through September and October on collecting and delivering food to this beautiful ministry! Let us anticipate what God will do with our gifts. May He bless each of you who continue to give so generously!

Trunk Or Treat:

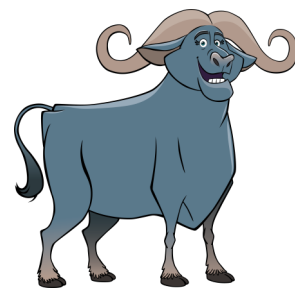
- We're planning to have a special "Photo Booth" opportunity for families.

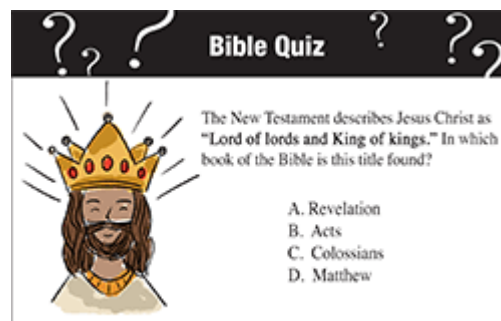
